Awards Title and Criteria

Student of the Year (Yr 12)

- A year 12 student who is involved across multiple extra curricular opportunities:
 - Sport; school teams, school carnivals, representative sport can act as a decider
 - Cultural such as public speaking, the arts
- High academic achievement
- Embodies the school's values

Zonta Banksia Award (Yr 11 Female)

- The Banksia award recognises a Year 11 female student who displays traits of honesty, integrity and self responsibility as well as demonstrating the tenacity to overcome any obstacle.

Veronica Cook Memorial Award for the Arts (Yr 12)

- Must be a year 12 student at Bribie Island State High School
- Must be a participant in either Drama, Music, Dance or Visual Arts
- Top points in cultural service is a consideration
- Participation in extra curricula endeavours would be desirable.
- Must have a high level in classroom performance
- Must have a level of commitment
- Must achieve to their potential
- Must give an indication that he/she is going to university/TAFE or higher education.

- Demonstrated outstanding participation/performance in:
 - academic
 - cultural
 - sporting spheres
 - community service
