A note from the Principal,

In accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at State schools who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents, is met by the State.

Parents however are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other resources for their children while attending school.

In recognition that these costs can be high, Bribie Island State High School provides an optional service to assist parents with the cost of these educational resources, known as a Student Resource Scheme (SRS). At Bribie Island SHS our SRS incorporates resources, texts and consumables.

Participation in Bribie Island SHS Student Resource Scheme is strongly encouraged. The scheme provides outstanding value for money as the school purchases in bulk to secure the best prices which, in turn, enables the SRS fees to be kept as low as possible. Participation in the scheme provides access to textbooks, resources and other resources and consumables.

All full-time and part-time students from Years 7 to 12 (with the exception of some international students) are entitled to a Textbook and Resource Allowance to offset the cost of textbooks and education resources. For parents who choose to participate in the SRS, the allowance is already provided for in the SRS fees. Parents who choose not to participate in the SRS however, are entitled to have the allowance paid to them directly.

Should a family choose not to participate in the SRS, the parent/caregiver is responsible for purchasing and providing those resources for their child whilst they are a student at Bribie Island State High School.

The purpose of this document is to outline the required resources for each year level. Indicative retail prices are also included to assist parents/caregivers in making an informed choice, should they be considering 'not participating' in the SRS.

We trust that the information provided in this document, affords parents/caregivers the opportunity to make an informed choice that best meets the needs of their family.

Participation in the SRS means your child will be supplied with the required textbooks, learning resources, and classroom consumables without families needing to shop for individual items.

If a family chooses not to participate in the SRS, parents/caregivers will be responsible for purchasing and providing all required resources for their child while they are enrolled at Bribie Island State High School.

Textbook & Resource Allowance (TRA)

The Department of Education provides a Textbook & Resource Allowance (TRA) to support families with education resource costs:

- Years 7–10: \$164 per student, per year
- Years 11–12: \$357 per student, per year

For families participating in the SRS, this allowance has already been applied to reduce the fees listed above. The amounts shown in the table reflect the full cost of participation minus the TRA held by Bribie Island SHS.

Costs Not Covered by the SRS

Parents/caregivers are still required to provide or pay for the following:

- Bring Your Own Device (BYO Device)
- Camps, excursions, incidental activities, Gala Days, extra-curricular and sporting events
- Instrumental Music fees and instrument hire (if participating)
- Elective subject costs
- CREST subject costs (if participating)

Our goal is to keep learning accessible, affordable, and well-resourced for every student. The SRS is one way we work in partnership with families to support student success from the very first day of school.
