#### 2025 Student Resource Scheme Information – Bribie Island State High School

Bribie Island State High School offers a Student Resource Scheme (SRS) to provide families with a convenient and cost-effective way to access textbooks, digital subscriptions, classroom consumables, and curriculum-based resources. The scheme is designed to reduce the financial burden on families by allowing the school to purchase materials in bulk and pass on the savings directly.

The Department of Education provides a **Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA)** to offset the cost of educational resources for students in Years 7 to 12. This allowance is automatically applied to reduce the cost of the SRS for participating families. For 2025, the TRA is **\$160.00 for students in Years 7 to 10**, and **\$348.00 for students in Years 11 and 12**. These amounts have been deducted from the full resource cost to determine the final SRS fee payable by families, as shown below:

Participation in the SRS is strongly encouraged, as it ensures all students have access to consistent, high-quality learning resources. However, participation is voluntary. Families who choose **not to participate** in the scheme will receive a detailed list of required items and are expected to purchase all equivalent resources independently. This includes textbooks, digital licences, and any subject-specific materials normally provided through the scheme.

In addition to the SRS fee, all families, regardless of participation are required to provide or pay for the following items:

- Stationery and personal booklist items per student
- BYO Device (as per school BYOD specifications)
- Camps, excursions, incidental activities, Gala Days, and sporting events
- Instrumental Music Program fees and hire charges (if participating)
- Elective subject fees
- CREST program fees and materials (if participating)

The SRS supports equitable access and reduces the administrative burden on families by offering a single, inclusive payment for a wide range of school-provided resources.
