## HOMEWORK CENTRE PARENT INFORMATION SHEET

### About Homework Centres

Homework Centres aim to support students' learning, development and engagement in school, and forge strong and supportive links between home and school.

Homework Centre sessions are:

- an opportunity for students to complete homework activities, assignments, or activities to support school-based learning such as reading;
- provided at no cost to families, including a healthy afternoon snack for each student.

***Students will not be able to access the Homework Centre without first being registered for a session.***

### Purpose

The Homework Centre program is intended to provide families with the option of supporting their child's learning, through after-school supervision by teacher aides.

The Homework Centre program is designed to:

- support students to develop good study habits and provide additional learning time for students;
- support students' learning, development and engagement in school;
- forge strong and supportive links between home and school; and
- ease the burden on students and parent/carers by providing a supervised and supportive setting away from home to complete homework tasks.

***Teacher aides provide supervision only to students participating in the Homework Centre program. Homework Centres are not designed to deliver instructional support, personalised tuition or academic support and as such, should not interfere with or replace any aspects of classroom teaching.***

### Eligible Students

Currently enrolled students in years 7-9.

- Maximum of 24 students on any afternoon.
- If under subscribed, the session will be offered to year 10 students.

### Days and Time of Operation

Days - Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday → 2:40 – 3:40 pm

Please note: The Homework Centre will not operate at the following times:

- the last week of term 1, 2 and 3.
- the first two weeks of the school year.
- the last two weeks of term 4.
- when a public holiday falls on one of the days of operation.

### Location

School Library - AV1 & AV2

### Registration Process

- Parent/carers must complete a **Student Registration Form and Medical Form** before any students will be enrolled to participate in the Homework Centre.
- Forms, hardcopy or electronic, must be signed, handed into the office or emailed to [office@bribieislandshs.eq.edu.au](mailto:office@bribieislandshs.eq.edu.au)
- Parent/carers will need to register dates for participation. This can be completed continuously, throughout the school year. Students will only be admitted for the dates for which they are registered.
- Parent/carers are to specify the length of time the student will be attending for each session, for each date. For example, Monday 17 August to 3:15pm or Wednesday 30 August to 3:40pm.
